

## **CORINTH VILLAGE VOTERS**

The Village of Corinth will hold a General Election on

**Tuesday, March 15, 2016**

at the Village Hall, 244 Main Street, from 12:00 PM (noon) until 9:00 PM for the purpose of electing two (2) Village Trustees and one (1) Village Mayor for a term of four (4) years each.

**The ballot will also contain one (1) proposition as follows:**

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Corinth seeks approval of an amendment to the defined contribution service award program, which was established effective January 1, 1997 and is administered by the Village Board of Trustees for active volunteer firefighter members of Corinth Volunteer Fire Department.

The amendment would be effective January 1, 2017 and if approved, would increase the service award accrual of a participating volunteer, from \$10 to \$15, for service credit earned by such participant under the program point system during calendar year 2017 and after.

The calendar year 2017 cost of funding the Village of Corinth volunteer firefighter service award program may be as much as \$38,000, plus the cost of administration of about \$5,000. The cost of funding the amended program could increase as much as \$13,000 for calendar year 2018 and after.

If volunteer participation levels increase in future years, the annual cost may increase further.
