

Notice of Public Hearing

Village of Corinth

Village of Corinth will hold a public hearing on October 1, 2025 at 6:00 PM at the Village of Corinth Fire Department Firehouse, 16 Saratoga Avenue, Corinth, N.Y. 12822 for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Village of Corinth's community development needs, and to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2025 program year. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$40 million in NYS Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds for PY 2025 for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. Village of Corinth is applying for total amount of \$2,000,000 in CDBG public infrastructure funds for the Village of Corinth Heath Steet and Hill Avenue Utility Reconstruction Project which is the replacement of drinking water, sewer and storm drainage utilities on Hill Ave, and the relining of sewer main and manhole structures on Heath St using a cured-in-place lining system. The improvements will address drinking water quality complaints, wastewater collection issues, and high levels of I&I to the sewer collection system. The project also includes full depth reconstruction of the roadway on both streets, and sidewalk replacement on Heath St. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program, including progress towards beneficiary goals and program objectives, and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals.

Assistance under the Community Development Block Grant Program must meet one of three national objectives: benefit to low and moderate-income persons, elimination of slums and blight or urgent needs affecting the health and safety of the community. No less than seventy percent (70%) of grant funds must be used for activities benefiting low and moderate-income persons and the benefit area must contain at least fifty-one percent (51%) low- and moderate-income residents.

Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. The Village of Corinth Firehouse is accessible to persons with disabilities.
